

Did You Know? Key Updates to the EHL Certification Scheme

At EHL, we are committed to ensuring that the certification of programs from schools of the Certification Network remain relevant and beneficial to students. Here's what's changing and how it impacts you:

What is changing with the EHL Certification Scheme? Starting in June 2025:

- Co-signed/co-branded diplomas will no longer be issued to students graduating from EHL Certified Schools.
- A new Supplemental Certificate will be introduced, issued directly by EHL and available to students from Certified Schools that opt into the initiative.

Why is the issuance of co-signed/co-branded diplomas being discontinued? This change aims to:

- Streamline the certification process and ensure consistent standards across all Certified Schools.
- Strengthen the global recognition and reputation of the EHL brand.
- Emphasize the only academic award issued by Certified Schools, complemented by the new Supplemental Certificate.

What is the Supplemental Certificate? The Supplemental Certificate is a document issued by EHL Group that:

- Confirms the program of study is certified by EHL.
- Reinforces your connection to the EHL Certified Schools Network.
- Must be presented alongside the diploma issued by your institution.

How does this benefit you as a student? **Enhanced Recognition** – Gain formal acknowledgment from EHL, a leader in hospitality education. **Stronger Affiliation** – The certificate reinforces your membership in the global EHL Certified Schools Network. **Additional Value** – While your institution's diploma remains your only academic credential, the Supplemental Certificate adds prestige and highlights alignment with EHL's high standards.

When will these changes take effect?

- Co-signed/co-branded diplomas will cease after the graduation of the 2024-25 cohorts.
- The new Supplemental Certificate will be available starting June 2025.

How will the Supplemental Certificate be issued?

- The Supplemental Certificate will be issued directly by EHL and sent to your school administration.
- It will only be valid when presented with the original diploma from your Certified School.

Will this change affect the credibility of Certified Schools' diplomas? No. The diploma issued by your institution remains the primary academic award and the main credential for students. The Supplemental Certificate serves as added value, reinforcing the connection to EHL's rigorous standards.
